

## MOUNTIE GUIDE INFORMATION PACKET

- General Facts:

- Mansfield University has approximately 3,400 students
- 16:1 is the student to teacher ratio
- All classes are taught by Professors
- The average class size is comprised of approximately 30 students
- Major related classes are often comprised of fewer than 30 students
- 90% of Mansfield Students receive some form of financial aid
- Freshman are permitted to have cars on campus
- Campus is non-smoking
- Dry Campus (alcohol is not permitted on campus; regardless of age)
  - o Some academic departments will dismiss students from major upon first alcohol related offense

- Housing (Resident Halls):

- 3 Residence Halls, 1 Greek Hall
  - o Each hall is co-ed by floor
  - o Laurel B is an all female wing
  - o Maple Manor is an all freshman dormitory co-ed by floor
- For safety reasons microwaves are not permitted in the residence halls, with the exception of the micro-fridge units, which are available through campus (explain)
- A Resident Assistant is located on each floor of EVERY residence hall
- A Hall Director is located in each residence hall
- Kitchen and laundry facilities are available in all residence halls
  - o Laundry is now free for students (no quarters needed)

- Security:

- There are 11 full-time campus police officers
- Emergency Blue Lights are scattered throughout campus
- There is emergency notification via cell phone and computer
- Resident Assistants, Graduate Hall Director, and the Assistant Director of Residence Life are professionally trained for emergency response

- Kelchner Fitness Center:
  - 3 Regulation-sized basketball courts
  - Volleyball, indoor soccer, floor hockey, and badminton courts can be constructed on basketball courts
  - 5 racquetball courts
  - Exercise and fitness room has treadmills, cross trainers, steppers, bikes, rowing, weight and cable machines
  - Aerobic classes available several times a week, Free for students
  - Various Intramural Activities/Sports offered (create your own)
  - Sauna available in locker rooms
  - Guest pass can be purchased for a visitor
  - Student employees are certified in CPR and First Aid
  
- Activities:
  - Over 100 on-campus clubs and organizations
  - 4 social sororities, 2 social fraternities, academic fraternities
  - Campus Bus Trips- normally \$5-\$10 (NYC, Washington D.C., Baltimore, etc.)
  - Team Spirit Bus Trips- support M.U. athletics
  - On-campus television and radio station (freshman can have their own show)
  - On-campus newspaper
  - Daily Digest (explain)
  - “The Hut,” is a dance club that offers movie nights, open mic nights, swing dancing, bands, casino nights, etc...
  - Several throughout the year: Musicals, Guest Speakers, Bands, Workshops, Sporting Events, Various Activities
  - Large concerts every year (i.e. Third Eye Blind, O.A.R, Smash Mouth, G-Unit, Three Doors Down, Emerson Drive, Lady Antebellum, David Cook, etc...)
  - Guest Speakers (i.e. B.D. Wong, Barbara Bush, Gerald Ford, James Earl Jones, etc...)
  - Mountie Express –Free transportation throughout campus and downtown 7 days a week (transportation to Williamsport, PA, and Elmira, NY shopping malls is available on Saturday’s)

- Local Area:

- Home of the “First Night Football Game”  
The “Fabulous 1890’s Weekend” celebrates this event every September
- Tons of fishing, hunting, skiing, snowboarding, and hiking in the area
- The Pennsylvania Grand Canyon is located approximately twenty-five minutes from Campus in nearby Wellsboro, PA
- Wellsboro, PA has several restaurants, a movie theatre, and Soldiers + Sailors Memorial Hospital
- Ski Sawmill is located approximately 30 miles from campus in nearby Morris, PA
- Campus located approximately 30 minutes from Corning, NY and 45 minutes from Horseheads, NY and Williamsport, PA
