Post Vaccination Hepatitis Titer Results Report

Students enrolled in the Dietetics, Nursing, Respiratory Therapy and Radiologic Technology Programs **must be immunized against Hepatitis B infection**. The Hepatitis B vaccination can be performed by your personal physician. It consists of three inoculations of vaccine. The total time necessary for the completion of the inoculations is approximately 7 1/2 months. For that reason, students are advised to begin this process early.

Health Science Department Policy for Hepatitis B Immunization

1. Upon acceptance into the educational programs of Dietetics, Nursing, Respiratory Therapy or Radiologic Technology, students will complete their Hepatitis B immunizations within a nine month period from the date of acceptance. These dates are defined as:
Date of receipt of advance deposit by the Admissions Office
OR
Date of completed change of major form.
2. If a student refuses to meet this requirement, a physician waiver must be presented detailing the special circumstances of exemption.
3. If a student fails to complete the immunization process within the allotted time, he/she will not be allowed into the clinical areas which may result in course failure.
4. Students demonstrate compliance with this policy by submitting, to their program director, a post-vaccination titer report documenting immunity to the Hepatitis B virus.
